A note on this report: The data for this report was provided on the basis of consent and was accurate at the time of downloading (see date above). The report only includes information for people allocated to the board's constitution.

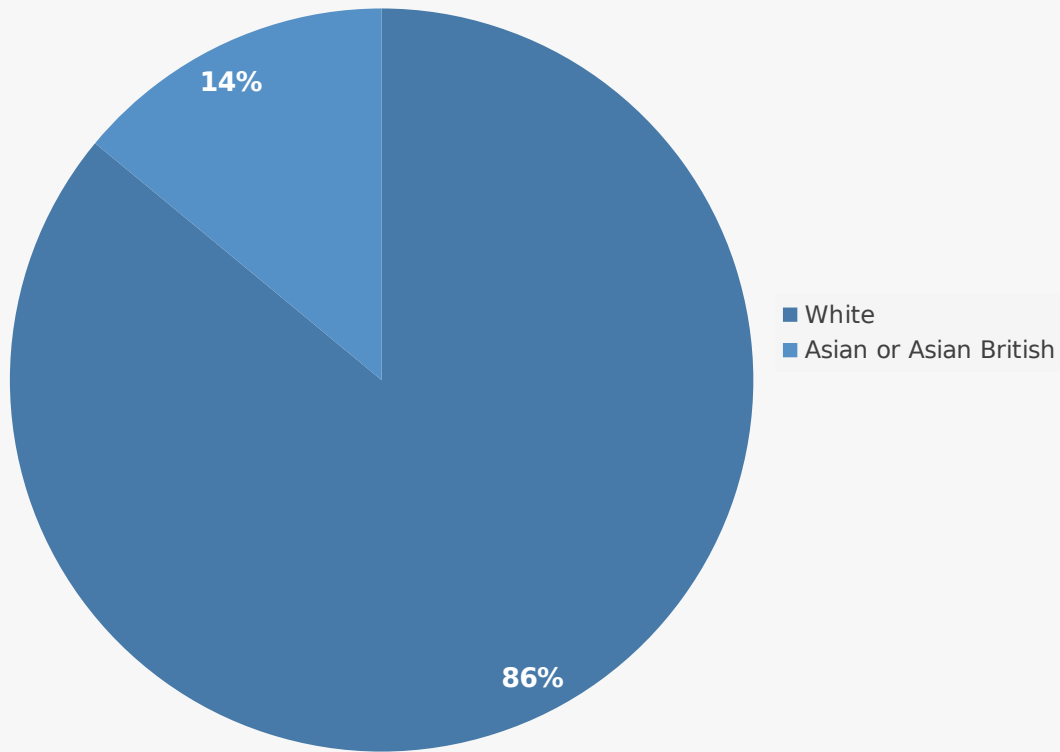

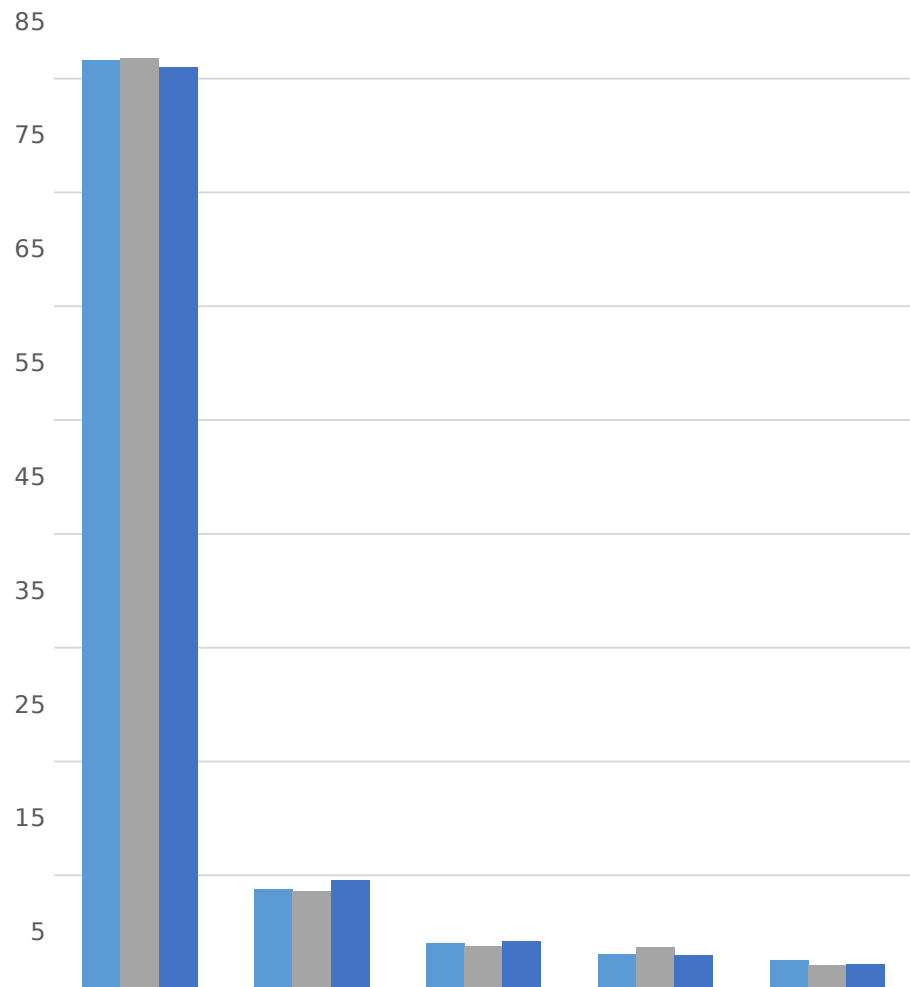


What is your ethnic group?



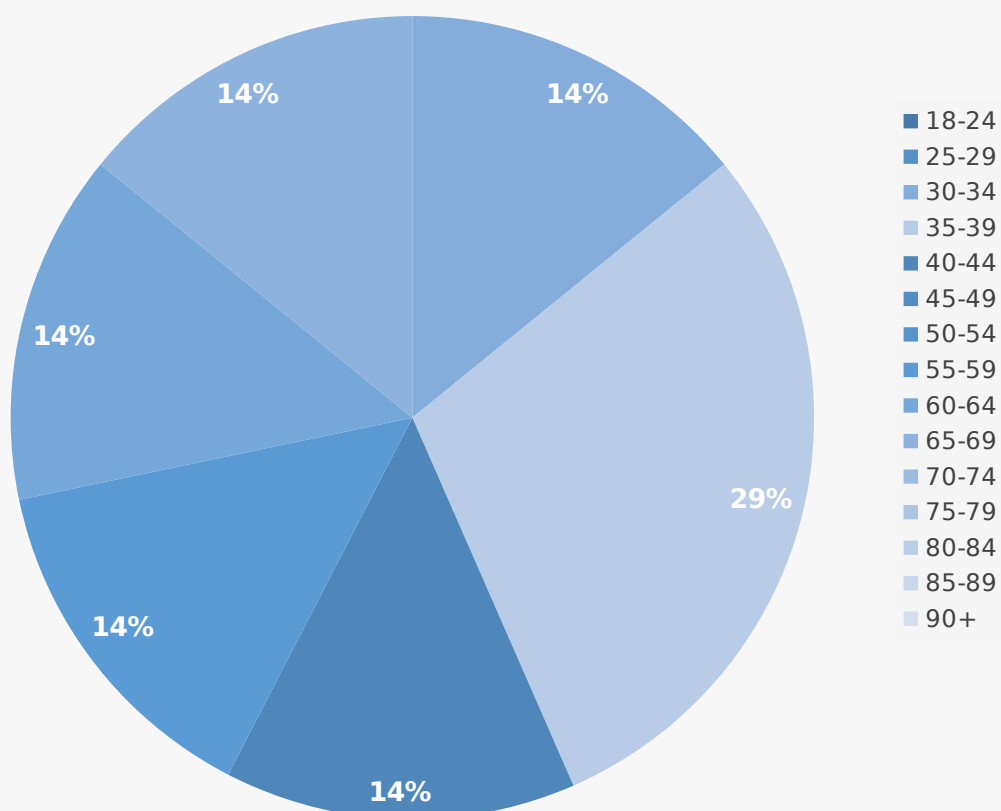

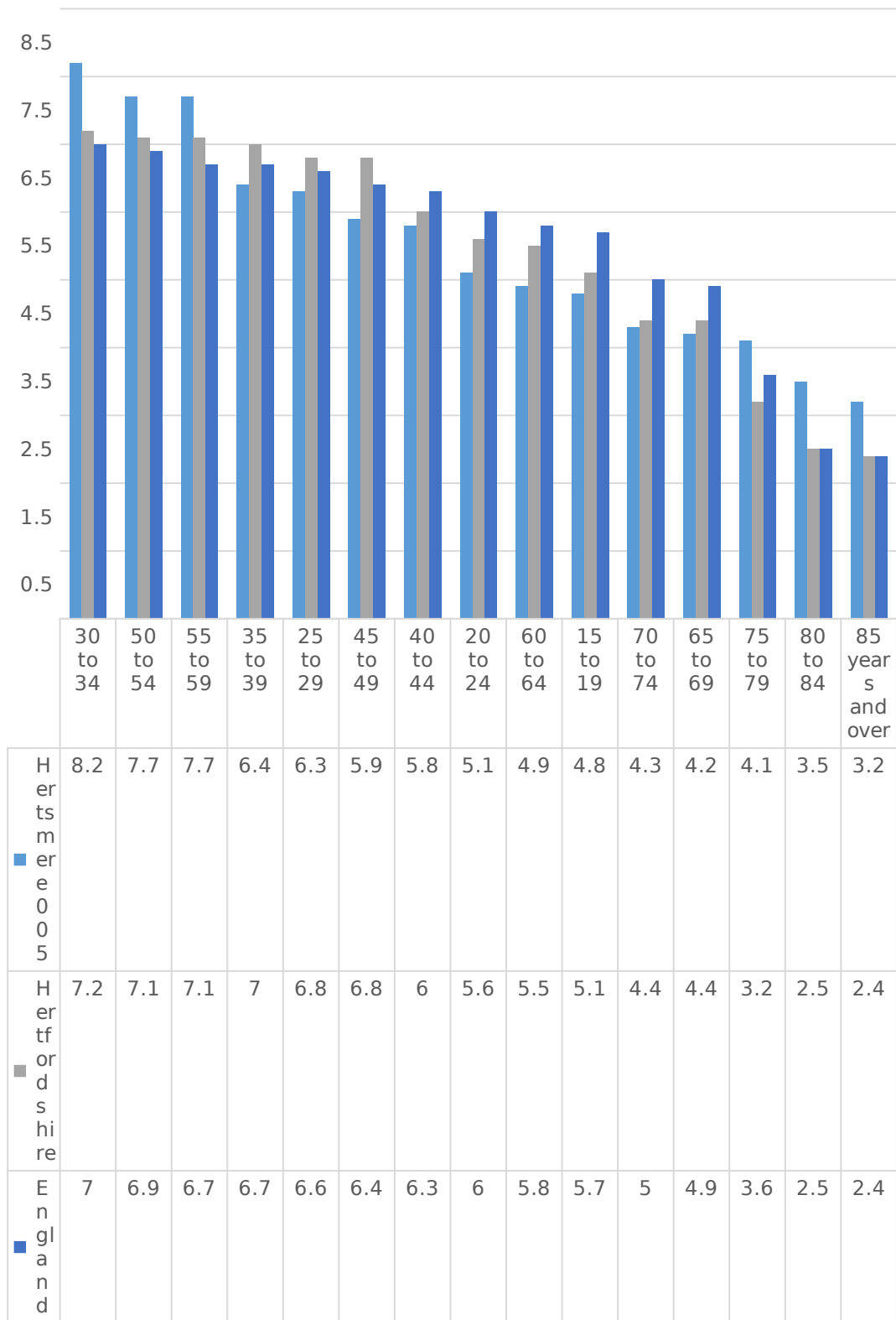

Percentage of governors by age band

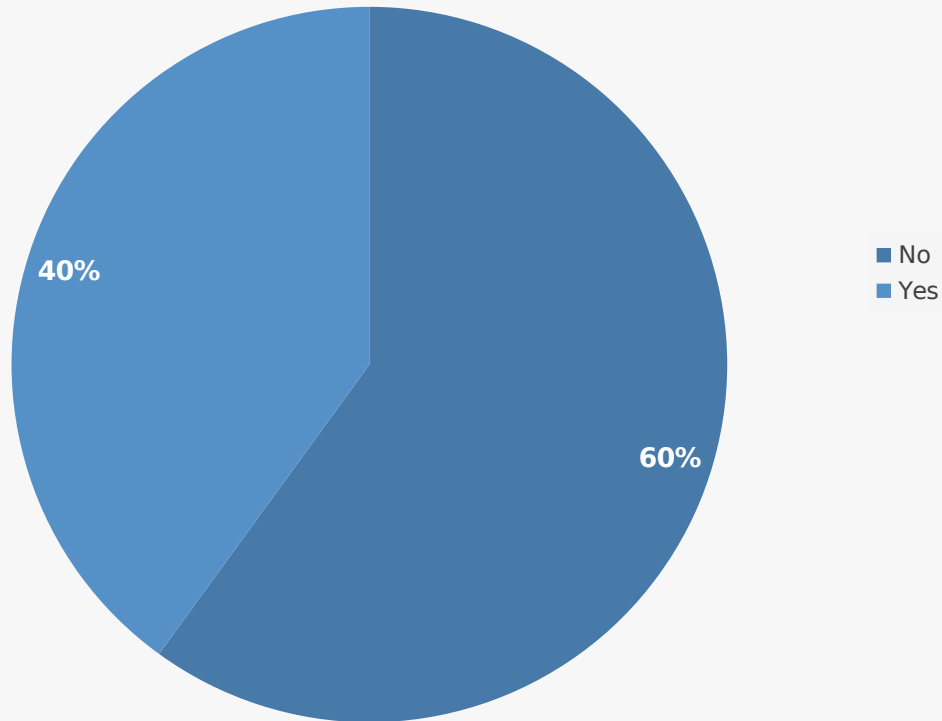

Census data: Age by five-year age band

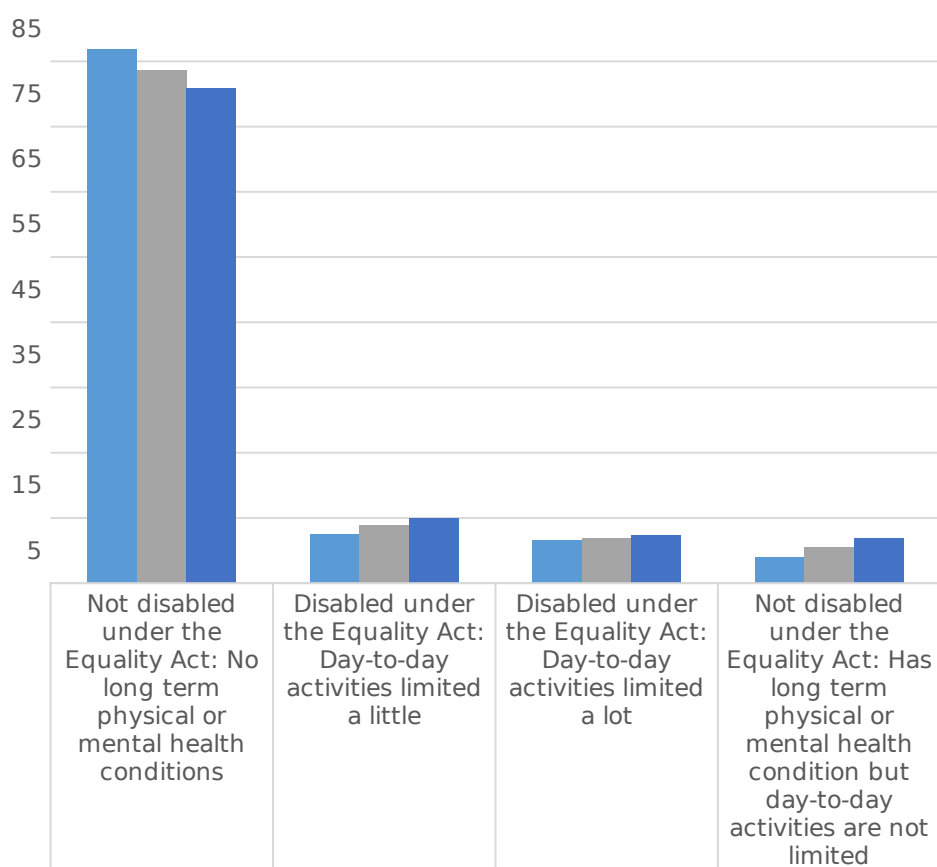


Do you have any physical or mental health conditions or illnesses lasting or expected to last 12 months or more?



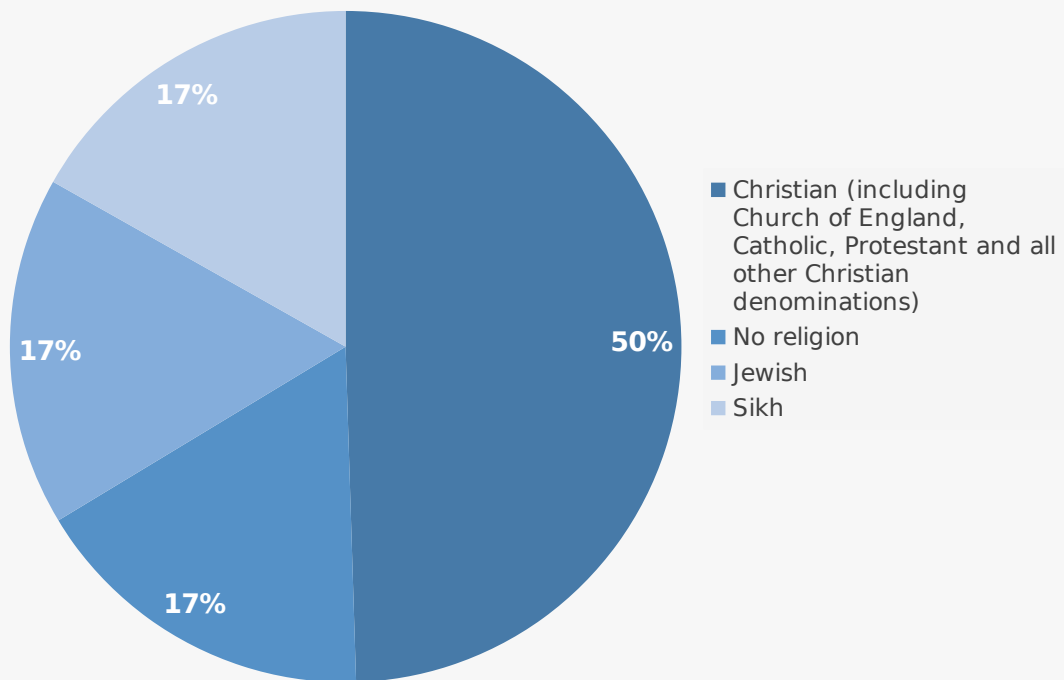

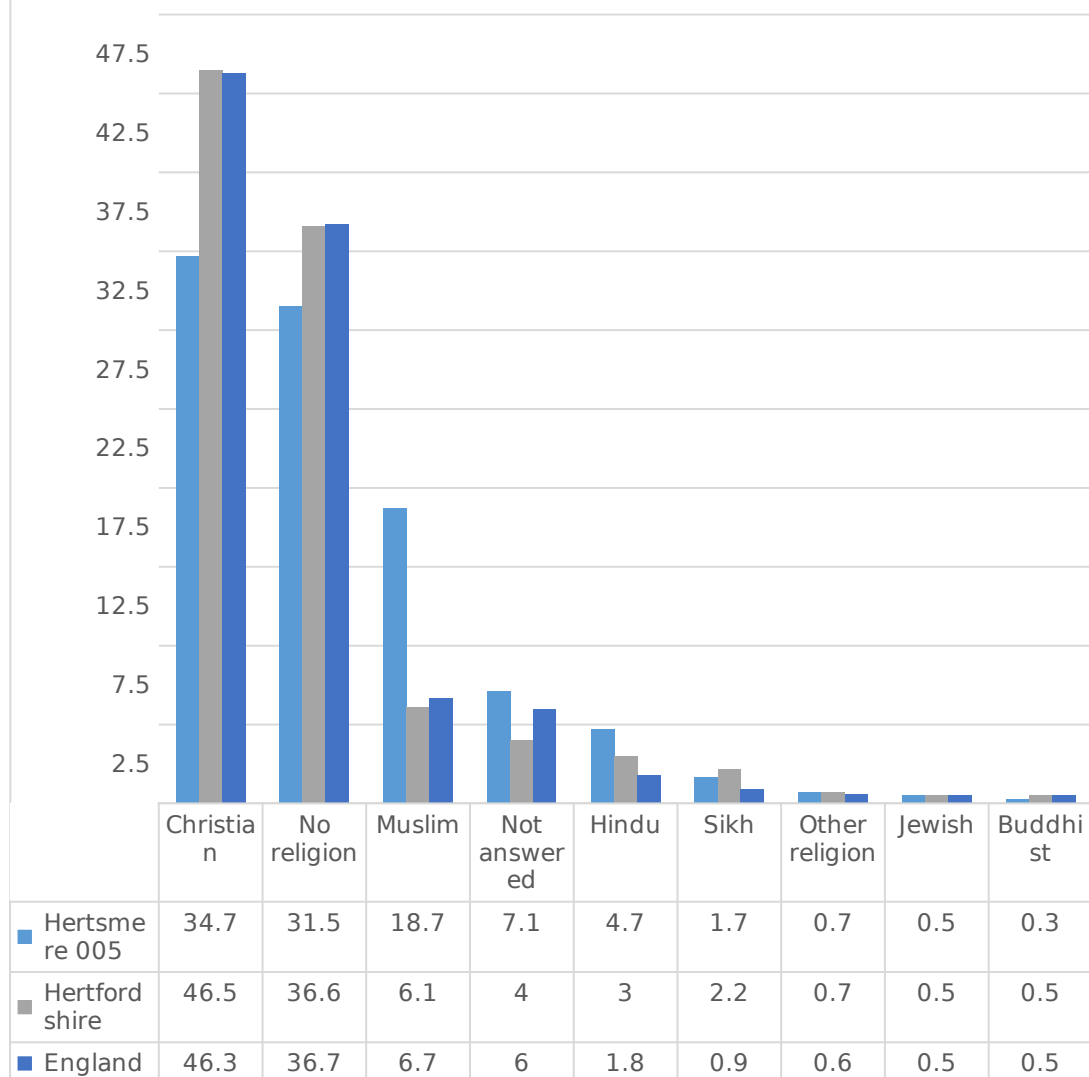

What is your religion?

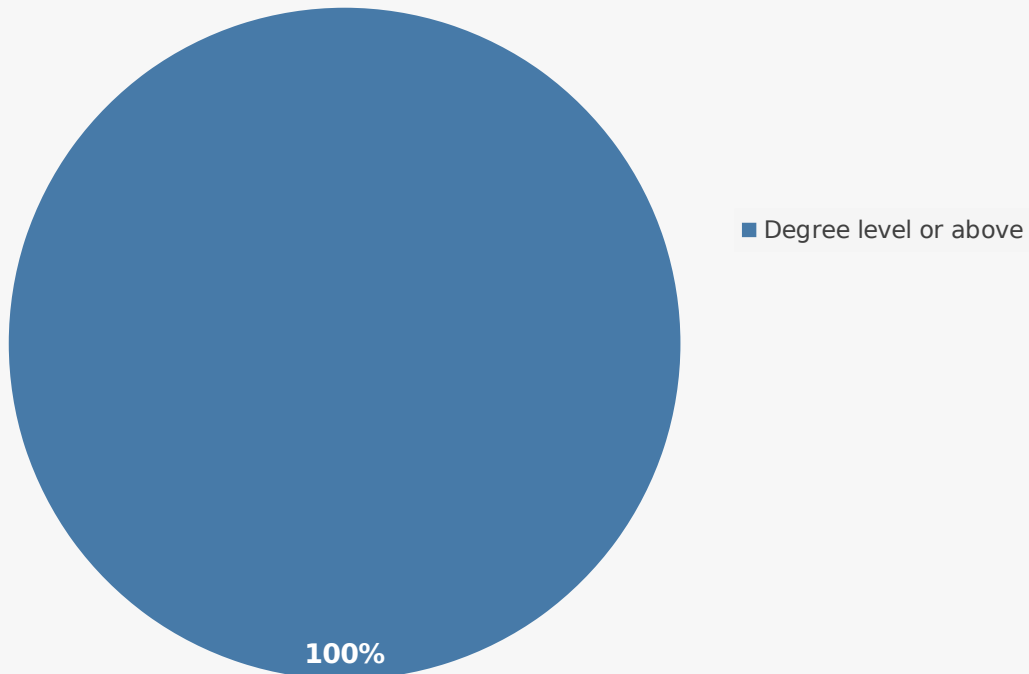

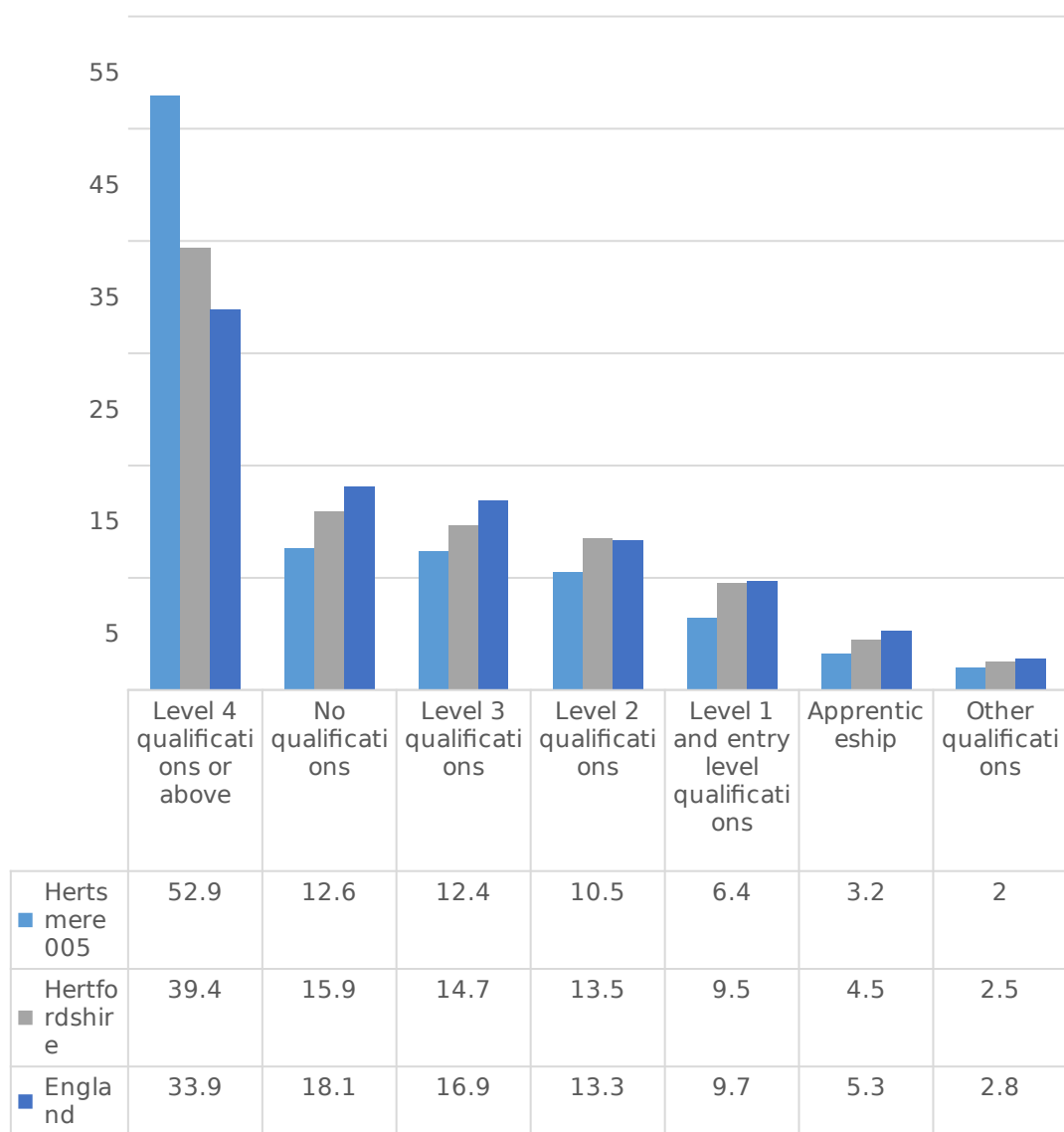


What is the highest level of education qualification you have achieved (either in England, the wider UK or elsewhere)?

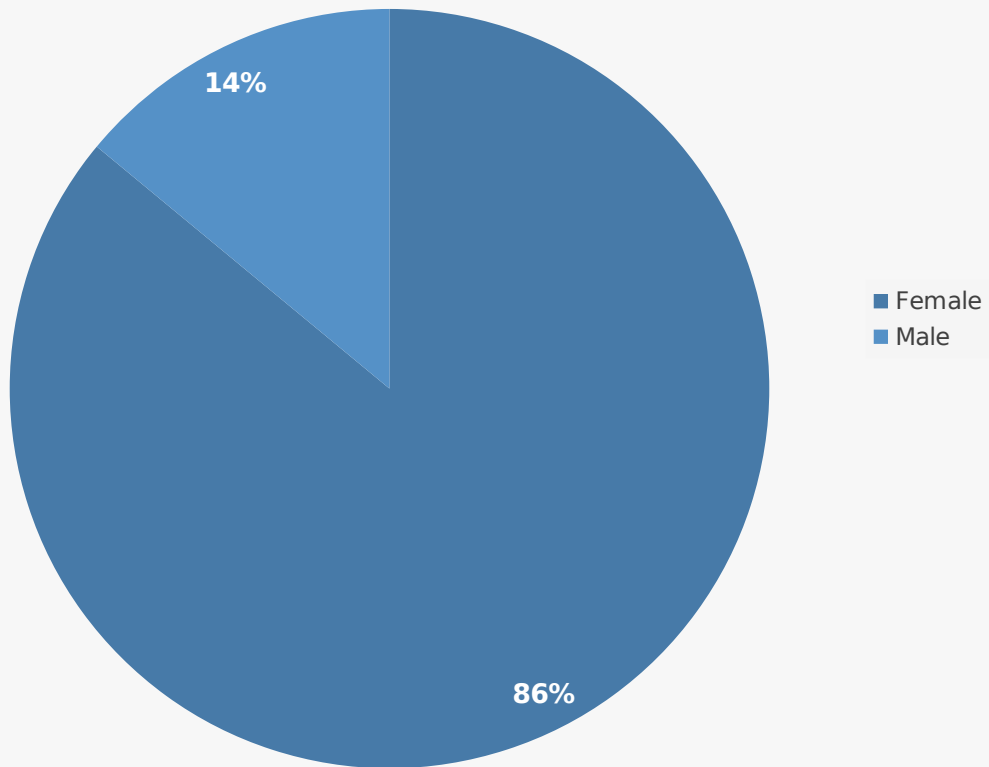

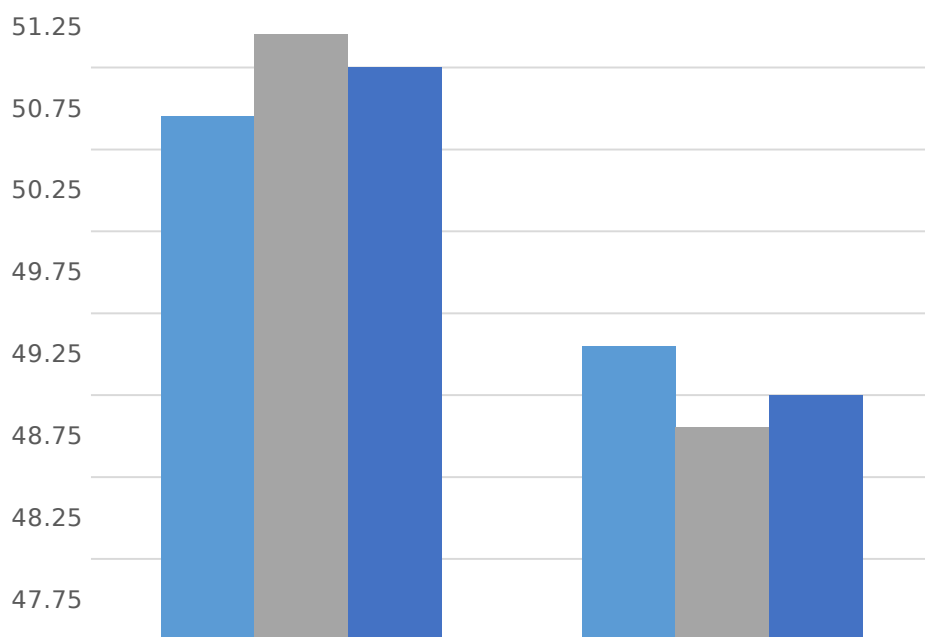


What is your sex, as registered at birth?



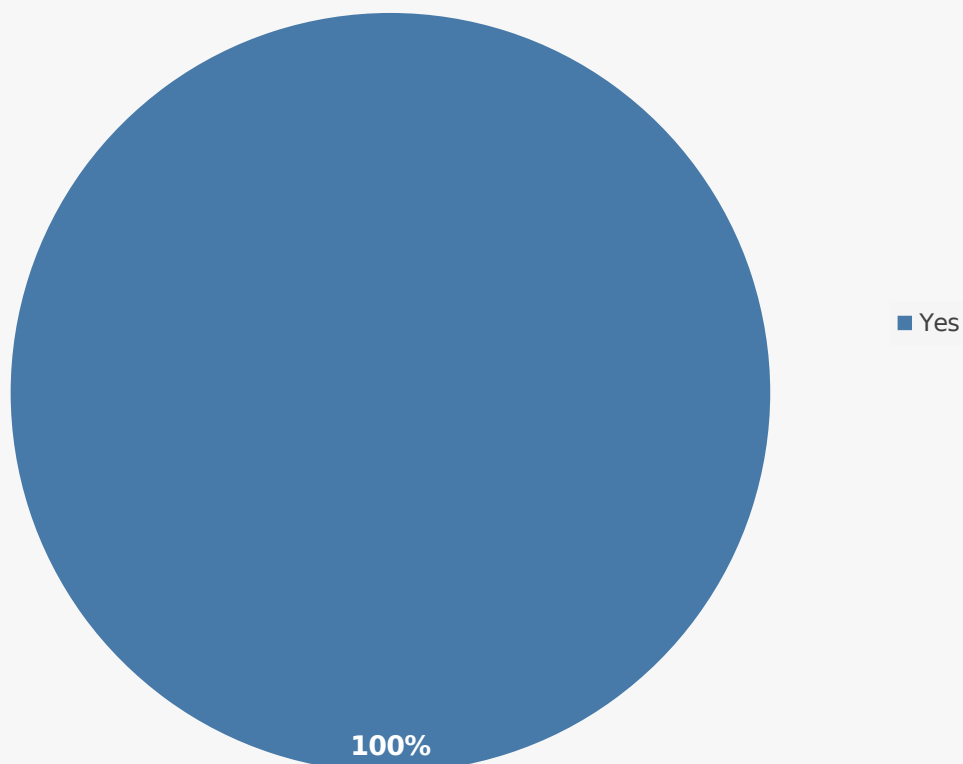

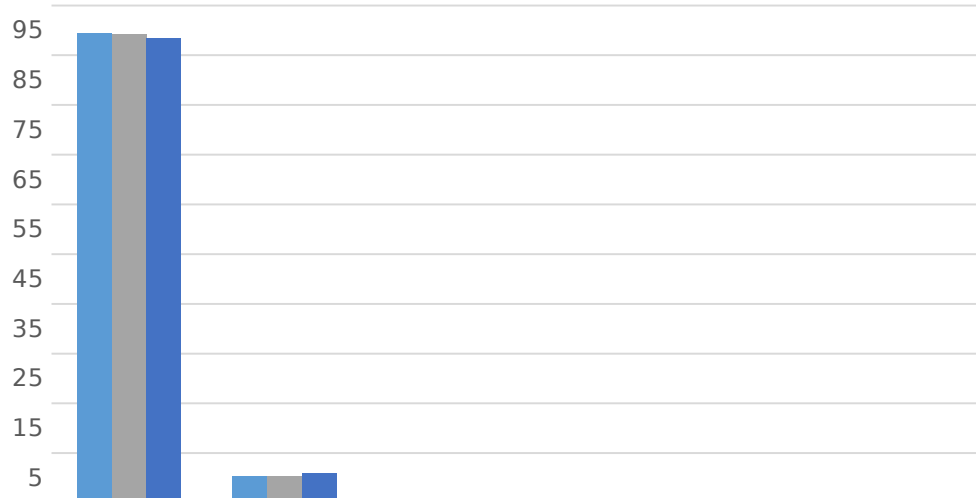

Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?



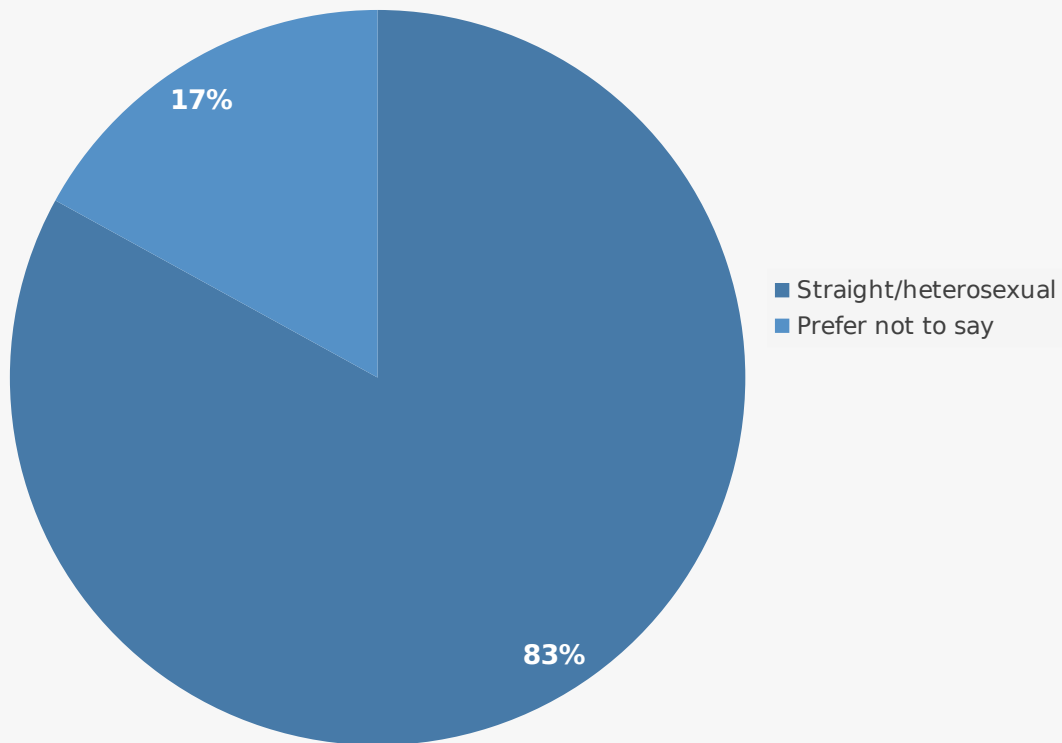

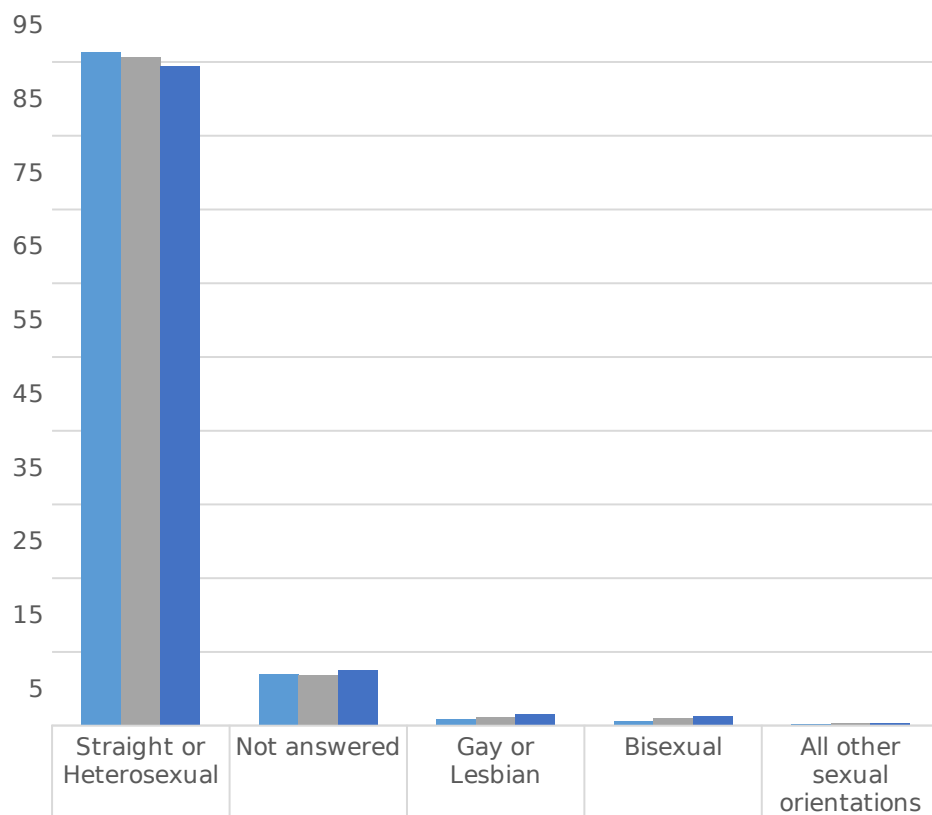
